Special Needs Adult Sex Offender Program

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This is a 12 month comprehensive treatment program designed for Adult Sex Offenders who have special needs due to cognitive, language, intellectual or other factors. Extra effort is taken by certified ISAT counselors to ensure the therapy is effective to these individuals.

The patient's family members, significant others and all others affected by the abusive behavior will be involved in the treatment to make the healing process as complete as possible.

ISAT has been providing counseling since 1983. Our therapists are caring, certified counselors specializing in treating sex offenders. A complete list of our services can be found at www.ISATcenter.org.

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

- Weekly Individual Therapy
- Weekly Group Therapy
- Family/Couples (3 per level)
- Education Classes (6 minimum)
- Psycho-Sexual Evaluation
- Polygraph Examinations (2)
- Progress Plethysmograph
- Sexual Reconditioning (if necessary)
- 20-hour Community Service Project
- Transition
- After-Care Plan



This program is comprised of 4 goal-oriented treatment levels. Each level is followed by a transition period. A review is conducted after each level prior to advancement to the next level. The reviews are necessary to determine whether the patient has achieved the goals of each level.

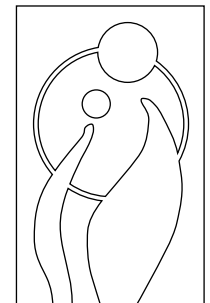
BASIC PROGRAM COSTS

Insurance

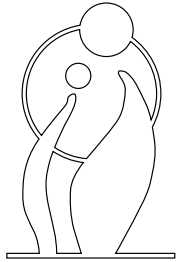
If your insurance provides coverage for ISAT therapy, it will help pay a portion of the rate. The remaining balance is based on a sliding fee scale.

Self Pay

The Self Pay plan is based entirely on a sliding fee scale of each client's income.

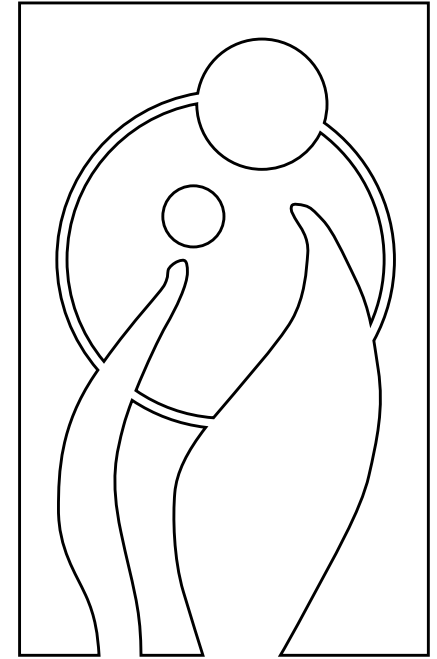
